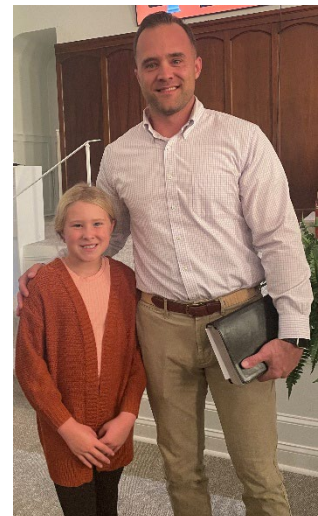

The kids will pack shoeboxes this year on Wednesday Nov. 19th and learn more about how the children receive these boxes.

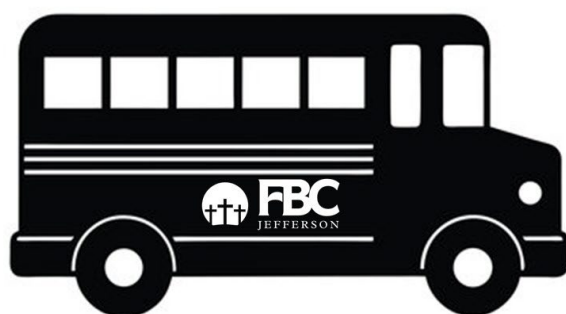
We will have Chick-Fil-A for supper upstairs and a special dessert.
