

Discussion Questions – Ephesians 1:15–23

1. What are some visible ways that faith in the Lord Jesus can be seen in a believer's life?

2. Paul thanked God for the faith and love he saw in the Ephesians. Who in your life shows visible evidence of spiritual growth, and how can you thank God for them this week?

3. Why do you think genuine love toward other believers is such an important mark of Christian maturity?

4. How does Paul's prayer for the Ephesians challenge the way we pray for one another in the church?

6. How does the “hope of salvation” described here differ from a vague or uncertain hope? How should this confident hope shape the way we live each day?

7. When was the last time you were truly overwhelmed by the glory of your salvation? What can you do to keep that sense of awe alive?

8. How can we celebrate the Spirit’s power in someone else’s ministry without jealousy or comparison?

9. How does Christ’s resurrection give you confidence in the face of fear, suffering, or death?

10. What comfort do you find in knowing that Christ is enthroned “far above all rule and authority”?

11. How can remembering Christ’s supremacy help you live with greater courage and peace in a world full of competing powers and voices?
