1. Why is it essential that walking in love and light carries over into our marriages and families rather than remaining only a church concept?

2. How does biblical submission differ from cultural misunderstandings of submission, and why is this distinction so important?

3. According to the sermon, what does servant leadership look like in everyday family life?

4. Why is gentleness a necessary quality of Christ-like leadership, even when authority, responsibility, and expectations are present?

5. How does sacrificial love within marriage and family relationships reflect the love Christ showed us on the cross?

6. The sermon states that marriage requires “two funerals and one wedding.” What does it mean to die to self in order to live as one flesh?

7. Why is total commitment, especially in marriage, so countercultural today, and how should Christian families stand apart?

8. How does our attitude and work ethic toward employers, employees, or coworkers reflect our walk with Christ?

9. In what ways can a consistent Christian witness in everyday relationships make a powerful impact on those who do not yet know Christ?
