

Discussion Questions – Andrew Brings Peter to Jesus (John 1:35–42)

1. Andrew did not only tell Peter about Jesus, but he brought him to Jesus. What practical ways can we bring people to Jesus today?

2. Why do many believers hesitate to tell others about Jesus? What fears or concerns commonly hold people back?

3. Andrew was clear and direct when he told Peter that he had found the Messiah. Why is clarity important when sharing our faith?

4. Think about someone who influenced you spiritually or helped bring you closer to Jesus. What impact did that person have on your life?

5. What kinds of obstacles might we face when trying to bring someone to Jesus? How can we respond when those obstacles arise?

6. The sermon suggests that interruptions and inconveniences can occur when we try to share our faith. How can we stay faithful despite these disruptions?

7. Following Jesus and sharing the gospel may cost us time, money, or comfort. Why is it sometimes difficult to make those sacrifices?

8. How can believers intentionally make time in their schedules to invest in the spiritual lives of others?

9. The sermon asks, "What is a soul worth?" How should the value of a soul affect our priorities and actions?

10. The sermon mentioned the joy that comes from doing what God calls us to do. When have you experienced joy through serving or sharing your faith?

11. Who is one person in your life you could intentionally pray for and seek opportunities to bring closer to Jesus?
