Day 3: Tasting God’s Goodness

Reflection

Peter reminds believers that they have “tasted and seen that the Lord is good.” Our personal experience of God’s goodness should lead us to pursue Him more deeply. When we recognize His faithfulness and grace in our lives, it strengthens our trust and fuels our desire to grow.

Illustration

Once you experience something truly good, you do not want to settle for something less. God’s goodness far surpasses anything the world offers, and once we recognize that, our hearts are drawn more fully to Him.

Application

Reflect on a specific time when you clearly saw God’s goodness in your life. Let that reminder encourage you to trust Him more fully and pursue Him more intentionally today.

Father, thank You for Your goodness in my life. Help me to continually recognize it and to pursue a deeper relationship with You each day.
