1. Peter points believers back to the suffering of Jesus. How should Christ's suffering shape the way we live and respond to hardship today?

2. Why do you think there is such a strong cultural push to reshape Scripture to fit modern moral standards instead of conforming ourselves to God's Word?

3. Peter tells believers to arm themselves with the same purpose as Christ. What does it look like practically to live with that mindset today?

4. Jesus was willing to suffer in order to obey the Father's will. What areas of life are most difficult for believers to fully surrender to God?

5. Peter says believers have already spent enough time living in sin. Why do many Christians struggle to let go of sinful lifestyles or habits even after coming to faith?

6. Peter emphasizes maintaining constant love for one another. Why is genuine Christian love such a powerful witness to the gospel?

7. What does it mean that love covers a multitude of sins, and how should that affect the way Christians forgive others?

8. Peter describes believers as stewards of His grace. What are some ways Christians either enhance or damage the reputation of the gospel through their actions?

9. James teaches believers to be quick to listen and slow to speak. Why is that especially difficult in modern culture and social media environments?

10. Peter reminds believers that true strength comes from God. Why is dependence on God's strength essential in overcoming sin and serving faithfully?
