

Enough Time in Sin

Reflection

Peter reminds believers that they have already spent enough time living for sinful desires. Salvation is not simply about securing heaven someday. It is about transformation now. Christians are called to turn away from old patterns and pursue a life that honors God. The gospel is not permission to remain comfortable in sin, but power to overcome it.

Illustration

Someone rescued from a burning building would not willingly run back into the flames. In the same way, believers should not desire to return to the sins Christ rescued them from.

Application

Consider whether there are sins or habits you continue trying to justify or excuse. Ask God to help you pursue holiness rather than compromise.

Prayer

Father, thank You for rescuing me from sin. Help me to stop clinging to old habits and instead pursue a life that honors You.
