Scripture: Titus 2:1

Reflection

Every healthy church begins with healthy teaching. Paul instructed Titus to "speak the things which are fitting for sound doctrine." Sound doctrine is much more than simply possessing correct information. It shapes how we think, how we live, and how we relate to one another. A church that is grounded in biblical truth is equipped to withstand false teaching, cultural pressures, and spiritual confusion. In a world where opinions change constantly, God's Word remains unchanging. Believers must be committed to learning, believing, and living according to Scripture. Healthy churches are built one faithful believer at a time as each member allows God's truth to transform every area of life.

Illustration

A building is only as strong as its foundation. Beautiful architecture cannot compensate for a weak base. When storms come, only structures built on a solid foundation remain standing. In the same way, churches and Christians built upon the truth of God's Word remain steadfast through life's storms.

Application
