Scripture: Titus 2:13-15

Reflection

Paul reminds believers that Jesus redeemed us and purified us to become His own people, eager to do good works. Christians are called to live differently because they belong to Christ. Our hope is not simply in this life but in the glorious return of our great God and Savior, Jesus Christ. Knowing that Christ is coming again gives purpose to our daily lives. We seek holiness because we love Him. We serve others because He first served us. We pursue good works not to earn salvation but because we have already received it through His grace. A life transformed by grace becomes a powerful testimony to a watching world.

Illustration
