SONG

INVOCATION

In the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit.

Amen.

TEN COMMANDMENTS

- 1. You shall have no other gods.**
- 2. You shall not misuse the name of the Lord your God.**
- 3. Remember the Sabbath day by keeping it holy.**
- 4. Honor your father and your mother.**
- 5. You shall not murder.**
- 6. You shall not commit adultery.**
- 7. You shall not steal.**
- 8. You shall not give false testimony against your neighbor.**
- 9. You shall not covet your neighbor's house.**
- 10. You shall not covet your neighbor's wife, or his manservant or maidservant, his ox or donkey, or anything that belongs to your neighbor.**

DEVOTION

The devotion should be age appropriate for all who joining together. Some examples of what you could do are: reading a few pages from a storybook Bible; reading a chapter from your favorite Bible translation; using a devotion book like Portals of Prayer.

With whatever you choose to do, it is also good to have some discussion after. Asking questions about what stood out or what you read shows us about God are helpful ones to start discussion.
