

Is God Real?

Even in Christian homes, kids can have different thoughts and questions about faith. Some may quietly wonder if God is real. Questions and doubts can come from many places - personal experiences and what kids see or hear in the world around them.

Look for and name different ways that God is living and active in the world, in your own lives, and in the lives of others.



Read Psalm 136:1-3

His steadfast love endures forever. This line repeats numerous times throughout Psalm 136 as a reminder to give thanks to God for His faithfulness in all He has done.



Read Psalm 136:4-9

The psalmist describes the great wonders of creation by God's hand. Psalm 19:1 says: *The heavens declare the glory of God, and the sky above proclaims His handiwork.*

GOD AS CREATOR

"By faith we understand that the universe was formed at God's command, so that what is seen was not made out of what was visible."

Hebrews 11:3

DISCUSS: Do you think all kids believe God is real?

DISCUSS: What are some reasons people might not believe God is real??

DISCUSS: What do you think God has to say about that?

SAY: You may have wondered sometimes if God is real. God has revealed Himself in many ways. Even though we don't see God with our eyes, we see the work of His hand all around us. When we see something carefully made, we naturally assume someone made it. A painting points to a painter. A building points to a builder. A book points to an author. The world is full of amazing design—from the tiniest parts of the human eye to beautiful mountains, oceans, and the stars above—all created on purpose by our powerful, all-knowing God.
