South Hill Bible Church



South Hill Bible Church (SHBC) in Spokane, WA is a church body that highly values God's Word, is caring, giving, missional and multi-generational. At 78 years old South Hill began humbly as likeminded people began meeting in a home setting for several years before the construction of our current building.

SHBC has a strong and welcoming family-oriented body life. Presently we average 300-350 for attendance on a Sunday morning between in person and online attendance. Our congregation is multi-generational and ranges in age from 0 – 100. The annual budget for 2025-2026 is \$645,000, with 19% of our giving designated for missions. Including additional offerings to missions outside of the general budget, giving towards missions approaches 25% of total yearly giving. The Lord has allowed us to be a debt free church and our congregation is very generous in additional giving for special needs and projects.

SHBC has Bible studies, Sunday Bible classes for all ages, small groups, Women's Ministry, Men's Ministry, Youth Ministry, Children's Ministry, a Young Adult Group up and a strong K-12 AWANA program. SHBC also has several opportunities for attendees to impact our community. One example of this is our close relationship with the neighborhood Grant Elementary School where we provide mentoring to kids from troubled homes, a summer camp, and quarterly events where SHBC families can serve families in the Grant neighborhood.

We are deeply involved with global and local missions as we currently we support 19 missionary families around the world and 6 mission organizations. Many of these families have grown up within our church. In addition for the past 25 years we have cast our missionary vision on our youth with annual missionary training and exposure opportunities.

Structurally, we are an Elder led church, with a strong group of deacons, deaconesses, ministry leaders and members under them. The vocational pastoral staff are considered part of the Elder Team. The Elder Team oversees the office of the Senior Pastor. The Senior Pastor employees all other pastoral and administrative staff, and since 2024 oversees 3 distinct teams to carry out his job description: 1. Preaching Team (of which he is an active part), 2. Administrative Team, and 3. Shepherding Team.
