I cannot adequately express the excitement and deep honor I feel at the possibility of joining the McConnell staff as your next Connections & Care Pastor. The story of how He has led us here is a testimony of His providence, and we are filled with gratitude for the way He has prepared us for this next chapter.

At the core of my calling is a passion to help people recognize the reality and beauty of God in everyday life. Taylor and I lead our family with the conviction that we exist to glorify God and enjoy Him forever. I believe God has called me to walk alongside others as we grow together in discipleship to Jesus. Building bridges for those who feel disconnected—helping them engage with the church and discover their gifts for service—brings me immense joy. My seminary emphasis was in Pastoral Care and Counseling, and that remains a central part of my ministry calling. I love helping people connect with opportunities to grow, serve, and experience the life Jesus offers.

We love the North Georgia mountains and consider this area home. But more than anything, what excites us most is the opportunity to grow in Christ alongside the people of McConnell—people who have invested in us, prayed for us, and loved us more than we could ever repay.

I am so thankful for the opportunity to come before you as a candidate, and I look forward to preaching in view of a call on Sunday, October 19. It will be a joy and privilege to open God's Word with you and to share more of my heart for ministry. PASTOR'S NOTE

Dear McConnell Family,

Fall is my favorite time of year for so many reasons. I love waking up to the cool, crisp mornings, watching the leaves change color over the mountains, and enjoying a big bowl of homemade chili! It's also my birthday on October 21st, in case you were wondering but that's beside the point.

Each year, I take time to evaluate every part of our Peak Kids ministry to see how we can continue to improve and ensure your children get the very best experience. That sometimes means making a few changes and this year, we're excited about one that we believe will make a big impact!

Over the past year, our 11:00 AM Peak Kids service has really grown, especially with the number of new kids joining us particularly in our preschool and kindergarten age group. Because of this growth, we feel it's the right time to split our 11:00 AM service into two separate worship experiences:

- One for Preschool & Kindergarten
- · One for 1st through 5th Grade

This change will allow us to offer age-appropriate teaching and worship tailored to where each child is spiritually.

What's Changing:

- Starting in October, we will only offer Peak Kids Worship at 11:00 AM.
- There will no longer be a Peak Kids Worship service at 8:30 AM.
- Sunday School at 9:45 AM will continue as normal for all age groups.
- Families who attend the 8:30 AM service are welcome to use our Family Worship Room, and of course, the nursery will still be available during all services.

To help make this happen, our amazing Children's Ministry Assistant, Alexis Brown, will lead the Preschool & Kindergarten group during the 11:00 AM hour, and I'll continue to lead the 1st–5th Grade group

You may already be aware that we've been using this split format on Wednesday nights, and it's been working wonderfully! Alexis has been leading our younger group, and I've been with the older kids, and we've seen great results.

At Peak Kids, everything we do is centered on helping kids find and follow Jesus. That continues to be our mission and prayer as we step into this next season. I truly believe these changes will help us reach even more kids with the love of Christ in a way that speaks to their hearts and minds.

PASTOR'S NOTE

Hey McConnell Family

Today I felt overwhelmed and at a loss for reasons I can't explain... Maybe you've had those kinds of days as well... Since the writing of my last article for the Inside McConnell, a lot has happened on multiple fronts. Sometimes, it seems so much is happening so fast that it's hard to keep up or to know what to do next. Think about it.

- Summer has come and gone. Fall is here and we are getting ready to enter into the one of the busiest times of the year.
- Pastor Danny and Retta have answered a new call to Biltmore Baptist Church and are now closer to their sons and grandchildren. I still find that one hard to believe but I definitely know that God's hand was in it from the beginning. I cannot tell you how grateful I am to have worked alongside of Danny for the past eleven years and how excited I am for the man God has led us to in order to continue the work Danny has been faithfully doing and build on it. While no one can replace Danny, both Danny and I believe he is the right one for the job. You'll soon discover why.
- The Founder of Turning Point USA, Charlie Kirk, was assassinated and his untimely death has left many shaken, but I also believe God will use it for good. I am praying that God will raise up thousands to take his place and continue to carry on the mission of speaking the message of God's truth and hope into a world that so desperately needs to hear.

So, what do you do when you don't know what to do? You do what so many others have done in the past. You go looking for help from the only One who truly knows what's going on and who is able to bring clarity and direction. King Jehoshaphat knew that feeling as well. When he found himself surrounded by a hostile coalition of enemies, Jehoshaphat did what we all do in hopeless situations: He cried out to God.

O our God... we do not know what to do, but we are looking to You for help. 2 CHRONICLES 20:12

That's risky and refreshing honesty for any leader when they're standing before their people. In front of God and everyone else, Jehoshaphat openly declared his country's weakness and his own helplessness, and he appealed to God for help. And that's when he heard from God

Think about it. Honesty, humility, and faith are the right posture for hearing from God about anything. Most of us cry out to God in desperate situations, but often with a sense of hopelessness and no real expectation that He will answer. But Jehoshaphat began his appeal differently (2 Chron. 20:6-9). He worshiped, expressed his confidence in God's power, and stated his expectation for God to intervene. His prayer wasn't just desperation, but desperation combined with faith. That's a powerful combination.

What desperate situation to you need God to speak into? Hebrews 11:6 tells us "it's impossible to please God without faith". The obvious implication is that faith pleases Him, even if its desperate faith. And it's God's nature to respond to those who believe. When you need God to speak, but be confident that He will answer, even if that answer takes time. Look to Him in every desperate situation." [Adapted from the One Year Hearing God Devotional by Chris Tiegreen].

MISSIONS



When is it okay to ask for help?

Why is it so difficult to ask for help? For many, the thought of needing assistance feels like a sign of weakness. We worry about being a burden, or that our request will be seen as an admission of failure. In a world that often celebrates independence and self being sufficient, turning to others can feel like a last resort.

But the Bible tells us a different story. In Acts 20:35, we read that Jesus himself said, "It is more blessed to give than to receive." While this is often interpreted as a call to generosity, it also highlights the profound blessing that comes with helping others. When we allow someone to help us, we are offering them a sacred opportunity to live out their faith. We are giving them the chance to be a blessing, to put love into action, and to experience the joy of giving.

Just as there is a blessing in giving, there is a profound blessing in receiving. When we humbly accept help, we are not only acknowledging our own need but also affirming the goodness and generosity of others. We are creating a space for community, for shared burdens, and for Christ's love to flow between us. It's a beautiful cycle: we give and are blessed, and we receive and, in doing so, we bless others.

So, how do we navigate this journey of giving and receiving?

- Turn to the Holy Spirit: When you are faced with a burden that feels too heavy to carry alone, or when you are in a position to help someone, seek guidance from the Holy Spirit. Pray for wisdom, and for the courage to either extend a hand or humbly accept one.
- Embrace Humility: Recognize that every one of us has a time when the load becomes too heavy. There is no shame in admitting you need help, and no pride in believing you can do it all alone.
- See It as a Shared Blessing: Remember that giving and receiving are two sides of the same coin. When we
 allow others to help us, we are giving them a gift—the gift of being able to live out their faith and experience
 the true joy of giving.

Let us be a community that not only gives generously but also receives graciously, always turning to Jesus Christ as our guide. If you need help with household projects that seem too difficult, please contact the church office for GraceWorks assistance.


What is designated?




