We are very happy to report to you that approximately 800 people heard the gospel preached during the various Christmas outreach events at our four churches! There were at least 50 who made a profession of faith and 7 were baptized in December and January.

Many of you have asked us for specific prayer requests. I'll share a few from each church: North Merida Baptist is the church that I currently pastor. Tammy and I rejoice in the tremendous growth that we have seen over the past couple of years. With all this growth we desperately need additional space. We have the plans drawn up and have a good portion of the money already saved – but we have not been able to get the building permits yet. Would you please take a minute (maybe a minute each day) to pray with us that God would work a MIRACLE so that we can get ALL the paperwork approved as soon as possible?

South Merida Baptist: Pastor Jesus and Eli, along with their church families hosted 4 outreach events over these past two months and have also started having youth activities every other Saturday. They have had several visitors as a result. Please pray for the salvation of these new families and please pray that many new families will be added to this church in 2020. Eli had a miscarriage a couple of weeks ago. Please pray that the Lord will comfort them in this time of loss. Their son, Victor, is 2 years old now.

San Jose Tzal Baptist: Pastor Jose and Marifer (and their 11 year old son, Pablo) along with their core group of church members do outreach events in other nearby villages every month. They now have 5 families attending church from other villages. Please also pray for Marifer's health. She has been suffering with extreme vertigo for the past year and a half. She has seen lots of doctors and taken lots of medicines, but nothing has helped much.

Ciudad Caucel Baptist: Pastor Erick and Cristy continue to see lots of growth in their church – especially in their youth ministry. They will be swapping their preaching service to the mornings and their discipleship classes to the evenings in March. Please pray this will be a smooth transition. Cristy has also had lots of health problems this past year.

Bible Baptist Seminary: our son, Joshua, is the president of our Bible College. One student will be graduating this May and several new students plan to enroll in the fall. 9 of our graduates are either pastoring churches or leading key ministries in their churches. We praise the Lord for this fruit that has remained and we look forward to seeing what all God does with this next generation of students. Josh and his wife, Amanda, have 5 children now: Gabriel (8), Michael (5), Bella (4), Selah (2), Malachi (6 months)
