Concerning David's throne...

Psalms 132:11 mentions, "Of the fruit of thy body will I set upon thy throne." In Luke 1:31-33, God promised that David's throne would be given to Jesus Christ before Jesus was born. (This works towards the fulfillment of the Davidic Covenant given in 2 Samuel 23:5, the everlasting covenant which is the eternal kingdom). It's important to note that Jesus has not received this throne yet. What these verses are teaching us is that Jesus Christ (sitting on the throne of David, Acts 2:30) will literally and physically sit on a throne in Jerusalem—Mt. Zion—and reign over His kingdom in complete fulfillment of the Davidic Covenant. Also note, in Psalms 132:7, the footstool mentioned is the earth (Acts 7:49) from which Jesus Christ will soon reign.

- 1) The throne of David is on the ground (Ezek. 43:7)
- 2) The throne of David is called "the throne of the Lord" (1 Chron. 29:23)
- 3) The throne of David is called "the throne of his glory" (Mt. 25:31)
 - a. The throne of his glory is on the ground, in Palestine (Mt. 19:28)
- 4) The Son of David has this throne in the Millennium (Isa. 9:7)

Concerning the fruit of David's throne...

Psalms 132:11: "...the fruit of thy body (David)..." We must remember that male seed cannot be involved with the "sons of David" and was cut off with Jeconiah (Jeremiah 22:29). We must also remember the **prophetic** words God spake back in Genesis 3:15, where He said, "I will put enmity between thee (Satan) and the woman (Mary), and between thy seed (Satan, and yes, Satan has seed) and her seed (Mary)..." And by the way, a woman does not have seed (only a man) and is the reason why Jesus **had** to be born of a virgin (Luke 1:27). So, the "fruit of David's body" is literally, physically Mary; and therefore, makes Jesus the son of God (conceived by the Holy Spirit) and has no human father. He is the "Son of God."
