We are so thankful for each of you that partner with us to reach these communities and reach these children for Christ!



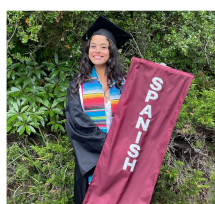
Our NLCS Graduates

We sure appreciate your prayers for our family and the ministry here. Since our last update we, along with the teams we've hosted, built over a hundred shanty houses for widows and homeless families, supplied food, clothes, blankets and Bibles to tens of thousands of people. We worked with the Mayor and had several free medical clinics, eye clinics and built three community kitchens. Most of these ministries are out in the villages that surround us in Lima, yet each week for over three months, we focused on going into villages that we've never been to before. It was amazing how receptive these folks were to us, but most importantly to the Gospel.
