

# THE AFRICA PROJECT

## The WHY

OHBC values church planting and missions; we see it as the most effective way of getting the gospel of Jesus Christ to the world. This year we are partnering with The Timothy Initiative (TTI) to reach more UUPG's (unengaged, unreached people groups). **The Africa Project** goal over the next few years is to plant 3,625 churches in five countries including Sudan (2,000 churches), Niger (50 churches), Djibouti (50 churches), Democratic Republic of Congo (1,275 churches), and Cape Verdi (250 churches).

The exciting part about this partnership with The Africa Project is that it allows us to diversify our Kingdom investment. This enables us to get the gospel into 3 areas where we have not invested yet. You need to know that souls will be saved, people will be trained for ministry, men will answer the pastoral call, and churches will be planted. There is nothing more dangerous to the powers of darkness than a single soul willing to take the Bible and boldly preach the good news of Jesus Christ to those who will listen.



### The NEED

The total need for the Africa Project is 1.4 million dollars. We know that nothing is too hard for our God to supply. The only question you need to answer is this: "Can God use me if I allow Him to?"

Our prayer is for God to use OHBC to turn the world upside down just like the Apostles did in Acts 17:6 - And when they found them not, they drew Jason and certain brethren unto the rulers of the city, crying, These that have turned the world upside down are come hither also;

Is there anything more important than seeing eternal destinations changed?



## The GOAL

Our goal is to see that 160 new churches get planted, which means 160 Timothy's will need to be trained. About \$400.00 will train a Timothy (church planter) for the work of planting churches. This is a 2 year training cycle which requires the Timothy to actually plant a church in order to graduate the program. TTI will hold these men accountable by inspection of the ministries under the leadership of a Paul.

# How will you allow God to use you this year?

Our goal is to raise **\$65,000** which will train **160 church planters**. We will receive the offering for this work on **Tuesday night** of Go Conference.

Our family of four came to Zambia in 1998. My daughter was just 3 years old, and my son was 11 months old. We started going out for evangelism and then discipleship. We started our BIble study in the same month and a Bible club for children. We started our church services after a few months of being in the field. In the same year, we also began our Bible School, training men and women for full-time service. In 2002, the Lord blessed us with twin girls while in the field. For 27 years in the field, we have been able to train many Zambians to preach the gospel and have started many churches in many villages. We also started three Bible School centers in three different villages, and had more than 30 graduates for our first batch last year. Currently, we are busy with our Bible School in town and 3 Bible school centers in different villages where we travel every month to conduct a 3-4 day intensive Bible teaching. For our other 3 centers, our Pastors will continue in our absence; due to the bad road, we cannot go.

## About

In 2012, my wife and I plugged into ministry at Midtown Baptist Temple, where the Lord envisioned us to adopt a "Whatever, Wherever, Whenever" mentality in serving Him. ### About

Bob and Tessa, both from West Virginia, have 3 children, Allysa, Allison and Ashton, and 4 grandchildren. They recently celebrated 28 years of marriage.

The Yeater's missionary journey began in 2005 with 2 years of it being fundraising and preaching. In 2008, they spent 1 year in San Jose Costa Rica at Spanish school and working with Nicaraguan refugees in the city dump. From 2009-2013, they spent 5 years in Merida, Mexico and worked as a family to plant the Community Baptist Church. As of 2025, they've spent almost 12 years in Guatemala, working in 3 villages. They helped plant Rock of Salvation church in San Jose Poaquil, Guatemala and continue to mentor and train pastor Abel Hernandez in his family and ministry. They host a regional pastoral training conference for indigenous pastors annually, each October, as well as run a women's program and children's feeding and Bible program that averages 400 weekly. The Yeater's receive 10-20 missions groups per yer, exposing them to the international side of the Great Commission. God has blessed them with property that they hope to build a storage facility on, and a permanent mission home in San Juan del Obispo, Guatemala by the end of 2027.

Beyond existing to proclaim the gospel, their heart is the power and equipping of our national team members in Guatemala to carry out the daily and future work of this ministry.
