

Hello everyone!

The summer is winding down, and here in Hungary this is the last week before school starts September 1st. We have had a wonderful summer, full of visitors and progress. I'd like to briefly share with you all what happened in August, and recap our summer.

August

In August we had a young man from Living Faith in Lee's Summit, MO come and spend a week with our family. Mason helped me with several projects in the church I needed to complete, and he was able to come to our church service on Sunday and experience what that was like. We did some sightseeing, and even visited the small village where the first Hungarian bible was printed. There they had a small museum, as well as one of the last remaining original bibles from 1590. It was a great week, and we are thankful for Mason coming and spending time with our family!





We had an interesting Sunday morning service in August too. On August 17th, I was at the church early with the worship team for rehearsal. Shortly into rehearsal the power went out. Not just in the church, but the whole street! After an hour the power still wasn't on, so we started the service in the dark without the sound system. Just the acoustic guitar and a cajon. After 3 songs the power came back on, and we were able to play the rest of the songs and preach the message with the power on! It was one of those strange Sundays where the routine was taken away, and it ended up being a very memorable service for all who were there.
