3 – Jesus is the only begotten Son of God John 1:14-18. 32-34

#### 1. As begotten of God, the Son makes us of .

The only begotten of the Father... v.14

The only begotten Son... v.18

And I saw, and bare record that this is the Son of God. v.34

Hebrews 1:5-6; Psalm 2:7; Romans 1:4 (Cf. Ps 89:26-27; Ac 13:33; Heb 5:5: Mt 1:20).

#### 2. As full of grace & truth, the Son gives us

& \_\_\_\_\_.
Full of grace and truth. v.14 John 8:10-12 (Cf. Lev 20:10)

And of his fulness we have all we received, and grace for grace. v.16. Grace for grace... can refer to grace's continual work in your life:

Grace that Saves (Eph 2:8)

Grace that Cleanses (Ro 6:1)

Grace that gifts you for service (Ro 12:6)

Grace that calls you to ministry (1Co 3:10; 15:10)

Grace to live spiritually (2Co 1:12)

Grace to sacrifice for others (2Co 8:9)

Grace to givers (2Co 8:7)

Grace to do good works (2Co 9:8)

Grace to endure afflictions (2Co 12:9)

Grace to hope in difficulty (2Th 2:16)

Grace to strengthen you for ministry (2Ti 2:1)

Grace that helps in time of need (Heb 4:16)

Grace to forgive others (Heb 12:15)

Grace in humility (Ja 4:6)

Grace in marriage (1Pe 3:7)

Grace in suffering (1Pe 5:10)

Grace for grace... Can also refer to receiving grace for the purpose of giving grace to others.

Law was given by Moses, but grace and truth came by Jesus Christ. v.17 Hebrews 10:4 (Cf. 1Ti 1:8-11).

God calls Moses "my servant" (Nu 12:7), but He calls Jesus "my beloved Son" (Lu:935). As the Son is greater than the servant (Gal 4:7; Jo 8:35; Lu 15:19-24), Jesus is better than Moses (Heb 3:1-6), and the grace and truth He gives is better than the law that Moses gives.

# 3. As bearing the glory of God, the Son declares to us the \_\_\_\_\_.

And we beheld his glory... as of the only begotten of the Father... v.14 Jesus manifests God's glory (*Cf. Heb 1:3; Is 40:5; 60:1-2*) through miracles (*Jo 2:11; 11:40*), in His transfiguration (*Mt 17:1-5; 2Pe 1:17-18*), and in the preaching of the gospel (2Co 4:4-6).

No man hath seen God at any time... v.18 (Cf. 1Ti 1:17; Ro 1:20; Heb 11:27; 1Jo 4:12)

He hath declared him. v.18

Colossians 1:13-15; Hebrews 1:2-3; John 14:6-9; 1 Timothy 3:16

- In His BIRTH, His glory RESOUNDED in the heavens from the throne of the Father. (Lu 2:13-14)
- In His CHILDHOOD, He RESIGNED Himself to the business of the Father (Lu 2:49)
- In His HUMANITY, He RELIED upon the strength of the Father. (Jo 5:19, 30)
- In His BAPTISM, His identity was REVEALED by the voice of the Father. (Mt 3:16-17)
- In His TEMPTATION, He RESISTED by the word of the Father. (Mt 4:4, 7, 10)
- In His MINISTRY, He REFLECTED the attributes of the Father. (Jo 1:16, 18)
- In the GARDEN, He RESOLVED to carry out the will of the Father. (Mt 26:39-46)
- In His ARREST, He RESPONDED with the name of the Father. (Jo 18:6)
- Before PILATE, He REAFFIRMED that He was from the kingdom of the Father. (Jo 18:33-36)
- In His CRUCIFIXION, He RELEASED His spirit into the hands of the Father. (Lu 23:46)
- In His DEATH, He RESURRECTED by the power of the Father. (Mt 28:1-2)
- In His ASCENSION, He promised to RETURN in the glory of the Father. (Mt 24:30; 25:31; Ac 1:9-11)

## 4. As anointed with the Holy ghost, the Son baptizes us with the \_.

The Spirit descending from heavens... and it abode upon him. v.32 Luke 4:18-19; Matthew 3:14; Acts 1:5

The same is he which baptizeth with the Holy Ghost. v.33 (Cf. Eph 1:13; Ro 6:3-6; Col 2:12; 1Co 12:13)
