A Good Problem to Have. We've been in our office building basement for about a year and half. We started with about a dozen souls that first meeting, and have recently been averaging close to 50. We are maxed out at 56 chairs. Last week a visitor complained about not being able to find a seat for her family. Please pray that the Lord would provide wisdom and resources as he sees fit and uses this problem to mature our young church.

- Pray for our baptisms. We've been pretty creative, but running out of options especially in the winter. A nearby church offered to let us use theirs for around \$1,100/per session. As of now, we are seeing that as a closed door.
