



## 1. Jesus is the King.

*Rabbi, thou art the Son of God; thou art the King of Israel. v.49*

*Psalms 2:6-7 (Cf. Ps 6:69; 11:27; Lu 1:32, 35; Mt 1:6-16);*

*John 6:14-15; 12:12-15 (Cf. Ps 118:24-26; Zec 9:9); Jo 18:33-37*

The Christ is described to be:

- King of Jacob, King of Israel (*Is 41:21; 44:6; Mt 27:42; Mr 15:32; Jo 1:49; 12:13*)
- King of the Jews (*Mt 2:2; Mr 15:2, 9, 12, 18; Lu 23:3; Jo 18:33, 39; 19:3, 21*)
- great King above all gods (*Ps 95:3*)
- King over all the earth (*Ps 47:2, 6-7*)
- King of nations (*Jer 10:7*)
- King of heaven (*Dan 4:37*)
- King of glory (*Ps 24:7-10*)
- King of kings (*1Ti 6:15; Rev 17:14; 19:16*)
- King of saints (*Rev 15:3*)

*Luke 1:30-33 (Cf. Ps 48:2; Mt 5:35; 21:5; Jer 3:17; Zech 9:9-10; 14:16-17; Mt 19:28; 25:31); Zephaniah 3:14-16*
