Dear Pastor and friends,

It does not seem possible that 2025 has come to an end. We want to give you an update on what has been accomplished in Belize in the year of 2025.

YEAR END REPORT FOR 2025

1. There have been 119 people who have accepted Jesus Christ as their Savior.
2. Bro. Stanley Kilgore taught 2 excellent Expository Preaching sessions in our Pastors School and we are seeing spiritual growth taking place in some of our churches.
3. We have completed our 2 Sunday School training schools in Guatemala. The people are really enjoying the Sunday School.
4. We now have 3 of our "preacher boys" preaching on the radio that covers 60% of Belize and a small part of Guatemala.
5. Bro. Pablo Ixcoy has handed out approximately 40,000 gospel tracts in Guatemala City and outlying villages over the past 10 years. Guatemala is a predominantly Catholic nation with people who have never heard the gospel of Jesus Christ.
6. We are seeing the second generation of pastors rising up to take over in 4 of our churches. The older pastors have been with us for at least 40 years.
7. There have been several revivals among our churches this year.
8. We are almost finished with our double fence and gate around our facility — due to some questionable people using our hill for a hotspot.

This work can not be done without people and churches having a heart for missions. Thank you for your prayers and support for the Lord's work. The Lord will reward you when you stand before Him for your labor of love to spread the gospel until all have heard. May God bless you and your family and your ministry in 2026.
