*John 2:23-25; 20:31*

Facts about the new (spiritual) birth:

- Spiritual life is conceived by the seed of God's word (1Pe 1:23; Ja 1:18).
- As a child of God, you partake in His divine nature (2Pe 1:4).
- Your new birth gives you a lively hope (1Pe 1:3).
- The new birth cannot be attained by heritage, works, or someone else's desire; it is a work of God based upon your personal belief in Jesus Christ (Jo 1:12-13; 1Jo 5:1)

*And as Moses lifted up the serpent in the wilderness, even so must the Son of man be lifted up... v.14*

*Numbers 21:4-9*

- Who was this for? For those who were bitten. For sinners condemned to death. (*Romans 3:23*)
- What was provided? A serpent of brass was lifted up. (*John 8:28; 12:32-33*)
- What was required? Look upon the serpent. (*Ephesians 2:8-9*)
- What was promised? Life. (*Romans 6:23*)

### 4. LIGHT: Belief in Jesus brings you from

*Men loved darkness rather than light, because their deeds were evil.*

v.19

*For every one that doeth evil hateth the light, neither cometh to the light, lest his deeds should be reproved. v.20*

(cf. *Jo 1:4-5; 12:35-36; Eph 5:13; John 12:46*)

Supernatural life comes to personal \_\_\_\_\_.

*But he that doeth truth cometh to the light, ... v.21*

*Proverbs 27:5-6; Romans 9:8*

Later Nicodemus will try to stand for Jesus during the Pharisees' conspiracy to kill Him (*Jo 7:50-51*). After Jesus crucifixion, Nicodemus brought myrrh and aloes for His burial (*Jo 19:39*).
