Eventir Caal and Bro. Mark Bul, were saved under the ministry of Maya Missions and the Lord has really used them.

The Lord greatly used Bro. Stanley Kilgore in a tremendous way in our pastors school this past week where we had 47 pastors present. Bro. Stanley preached and taught on the order of the church—the responsibilities of the pastor, deacons, musicians and teachers. There were lots of questions and discussions and the pastors got some much needed help. We praise the Lord for this teaching.

As most of you know, we have had trouble with Belize Immigration in getting our Guatemala pastors across the border while others are crossing with no problem. The Lord removed the Port Commander at PG and sent in another Commander that is more friendly to Maya Missions. Praise the Lord for answered prayer!!

The new Emmanuel Baptist Church has been completed in San Vicente, right on the Guatemala border. I had the privilege of preaching in the new church. It is really beautiful. This church was built by the people with no financial help from Maya Missions. They sold their crops, sold tamales and cattle, etc. to build the church. It sets an example to other churches that they can do the same thing.

The new generation of younger pastors are beginning to replace the older pastors who have asked to be replaced due to their age and health. Joel Cu has replaced Bro. Juan Choc in Aguacate Village. They will have a laying on of hands ceremony this Sunday. We praise God for this younger generation who is willing to step up and do God's work.
