## MINISTRY ON THE ROAD

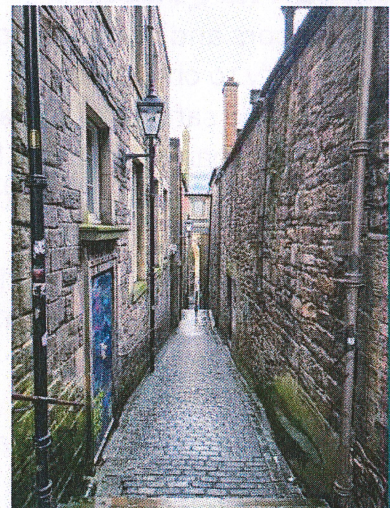
