It was probably close to nine years ago that a teenage girl and her younger brother were brought to church when their mom had kicked them out on the street. We have told the story about how the older sister, Yesenia, was saved when she was brought to youth group and that she gave testimony about how if she hadn't been brought to church and gotten saved, she had planned to commit suicide the following week. While we are very grateful for her salvation, we have not mentioned much about her younger brother, Marvin. For several years, Marvin struggled quite a bit and seemed bitter, not showing a lot of interest in church. I am thankful that his pastor, Pastor Jorge Uyuli, has continued to work with him through the years and has never given up on him. What I didn't know is that the Lord has been doing a work in Marvin's life over the past couple of years, and he recently asked me if he could give me a call. When he contacted me, he told me that the Lord had given him a desire to serve in the ministry and asked if he could take classes in our Bible College. This was very encouraging to me and to know that the Lord is still calling people into His service. Marvin is already taking some correspondence classes at this time and will be full-time in the Bible classes as soon as we return to Bolivia.

This past month, we were able to purchase our tickets and will be flying out on June 15th for Bolivia.
