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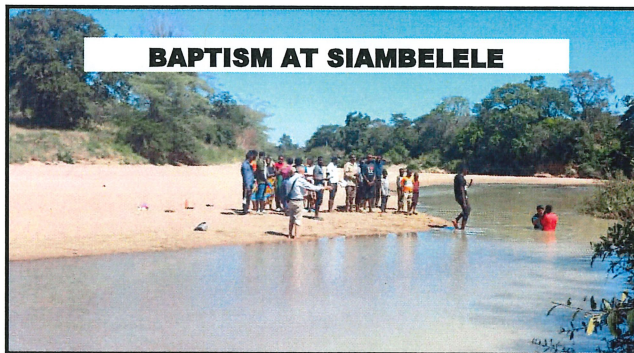

Greetings from our family and the brethren here in Zambia!

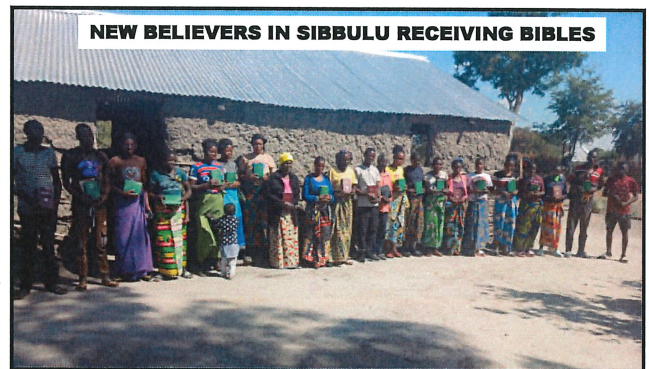
We thank the Lord for the opportunity to share another ministry update with you. We are truly grateful for your faithful prayers and financial support. Your partnership has played a vital role in reaching many souls for Christ and strengthening believers throughout Zambia.

The past three months have been filled with many exciting opportunities to serve the Lord. In the last week of April, we held our annual Youth Conf. More than 200 young people from different areas attended. We praise the Lord that several trusted Christ as their Savior, many rededicated their lives to the Lord, and others followed Him in believer's baptism. It was a great time of spiritual growth and encouragement for everyone involved.



During the month of May, we had the privilege of visiting two villages. Our first visit was to Siamabele Village, where many people gathered to hear the preaching of God's Word. We thank the Lord that many accepted Christ as their Savior, and fourteen believers followed the Lord in baptism. Please pray for Pastor Wilson as he continues to disciple these new believers and help them grow in their faith. Also pray for the provision of building materials so they can construct a place of worship. At present, the church meets under a tree.

We also traveled to Sibbulu Village, where Pastor Manfred has recently started a new church. We spent two days conducting a Bible conference for the believers. It was a blessing to see their hunger for God's Word. Some traveled as much as six hours just to attend the meetings and learn from the Scriptures. Several first-time visitors also came, and we rejoice that 17 people accepted Jesus Christ as their Savior. Truly, the fields are white unto harvest. Everywhere we go, there are open doors, and many villages are inviting us to come and preach the Gospel.



The month of June also brought many blessings. On Father's Day, we rejoiced as two fathers accepted Christ and one followed the Lord in baptism. We thank God for the faithful men in our church who are helping disciple these new believers.

Another blessing has been the weekly evangelism ministry of our Bible school students and staff. It is always a joy to share the Gospel with the lost and then see many of them attending church on Sundays. One of the greatest blessings came through a young man named Teddy. One day he came to our

church looking for work so he could earn enough money to buy food. I was away in the village at the time, so my wife gave him some simple work watering the flowers and cleaning around the church. Afterward, she provided him with a meal and a little money, and invited him to attend church that Sunday so he could meet me.

Teddy came to church that Sunday, where someone shared the Gospel with him. After the service, he spoke with me, and I had the privilege of following up with him concerning his salvation. He clearly understood the Gospel and placed his faith in Christ. Two weeks ago, Teddy followed the Lord in believer's baptism. He has completed his training as a tourist guide and is currently waiting for employment, but in the meantime, he has decided to enroll in our Bible school. Please pray that Teddy will remain faithful, complete his Bible training, and serve the Lord with his life. He is deeply thankful that God has given him the opportunity to grow in His Word.

This experience reminds us that even a small act of kindness can have an eternal impact. We never know how the Lord will use a simple opportunity to change someone's life forever.
