We recently celebrated our BBA End-of-Term Awards! It was a wonderful opportunity to recognize the hard work, commitment, and achievements of our students and staff.

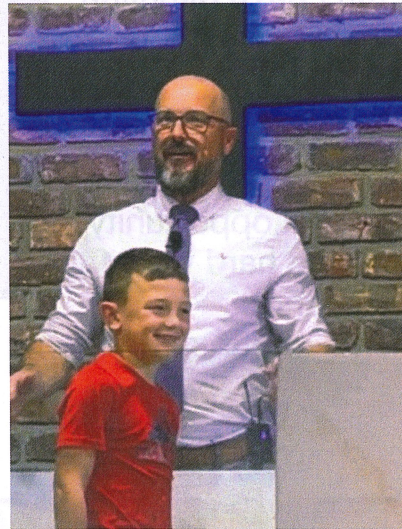
