I'm excited to present a terrific mission trip opportunity coming up December 1 through 13, 2027. Evangelist Scott Pauley with Enjoying the Journey Ministries and members of his team will be here with us in South Africa for a citywide evangelistic campaign and our teen camp at Camp Rhino.

We are opening this trip to young people 9th grade through young adults who would like to be a part of this great missions team. Come and help us reach our city with the Gospel! We are honored to have Brother Pauley and his team and look forward to seeing how the Lord will use them during their time here.

Construction at Camp Rhino has progressed nicely. Our new lodge is almost complete, and we should be able to use it for our men's retreat coming up this weekend. We have men coming from our team of churches all over the city who will be able to take advantage of the new space.

Our next project is our missions team lodge, which, Lord willing, will be available by next summer. One of

our supporting churches has already sent \$5,000 to start construction, and we'll need about \$40,000 more to complete this eight bedroom lodge project.

They are having a great time learning under veteran missionaries as they finish their missions training through the Vision School of Missions. Please pray for them during these next several months.

Please be praying for Michael and Victoria Turner, who just arrived in Burkina Faso to begin language school. They did a terrific job raising support and are grateful to finally be on the field. They will certainly appreciate your prayers during the coming months as they tackle learning French.

We have two missionary units who will be finishing their deputation at the end of the year. Noah Haught plans to arrive in South Africa in December, and Blaine and Holly Hooper plan to arrive in January. We're excited to see how the Lord has grown the South Africa team and look forward to seeing more people reached with the Gospel and more churches started through these new missionaries.
