Greetings from Yopal, Casanare. We thank the Lord for this opportunity to be in contact with you by means of this letter. Thank you for taking the time to read it and pray for us here in Colombia.

Presidential Inauguration

Colombia's new President Abelardo de la Espriella took office the seventh of August. After a close election, and for security reasons, he was inaugurated in Cali and not in Bogotá. He was met with a great challenge due to the earthquake that hit three days later.

Major news sources attribute several forest fires to being due to criminal activities. In a Presidential election, Colombia has normally faced violence and protests. The President is committed to fight corruption, narco-terrorism, and other illegal activities.

Preaching In Yopal

I had the opportunity to preach a couple of times in the small church here in Yopal. We look forward to starting a new church somewhere in the city. We have not located a new place to have services in. Esteban, Martha's nephew and his older brother Omar Daniel plan to be with us as we start to find a place to locate. Also, I was asked to speak at the church in Bogotá at the end of August before heading to Yopal.

Earthquake

We were in Bogotá on the tenth of August when the earthquake hit. Thank the Lord there was very little damage in and near Bogotá.

Several months ago, we signed up to go to a family conference for families in the ministry. It was right in the area where the quake hit. Several hundred died and billions of dollars of damage was done in the many towns and small cities of the coffee growing region. Getting to see that area and attend the conference was great. It was really sad to see that many suffering loss that have nowhere to turn for help.

Economy

One of the difficulties we have now is the falling value of the dollar. In one year, the dollar has lost about 25% of its value. We know the Lord is in control.

Timothy

Thank the Lord, Timothy returned to Pensacola the twenty-ninth of August. Please help us pray for him as he studies. Also, even more important is that the Lord would lead him and help him to find godly and humble people to associate with.

Health

We have been working to get several of the medical exams done that we have been behind on. We still are going in and out of Tunja, Bogotá, and Yopal. Thank the Lord, the report on the cancer in my neck was good and I will have follow up exams in six months (Lord willing). Overall, my follow-up with the urologist was good. He emphasizes the need for reconstructive surgery for my bladder and prostate.

Also, we thank the Lord that the tests and MRI were good for Martha's follow-ups.
